***Dvořák Dumky Trio highlights October 20 concert***

(Vancouver, WA) Fall is here and the second season of **The Vancouver Symphony Chamber Group** is in full swing. The second concert of the season, *Autumn Glory*, celebrates the changing of the leaves with a quartet of extraordinary Northwest musicians on Saturday, October 20 at 7 pm at Trinity Lutheran Church, at 309 West 39<sup>th</sup> Street in Vancouver.

The program will include:

Sonata No. 12 in E flat major, K. 380, for violin and piano (1781) by Mozart

Trio for clarinet, violin and piano by Khachaturian

Cello Sonata by Rachmaninoff

Second Waltz from the Suite No. 2 for Jazz Orchestra for clarinet, violin, cello and piano by Shostakovich

Trio in E minor Op. 90, "Dumky Trio," for violin, cello and piano by Dvořák

This 2012-2013 chamber season presents some of the world's greatest music performed in an intimate setting. The VSO Chamber Group is under the direction of Dr. Michael C. Liu. Among the highlights of future concerts are the return, by popular demand, of Russian violinist Tatiana Kolchanova and pianist Lena Vozheiko-Wheaton performing Stravinsky's *Soldier's Tale*, with a guest appearance by clarinetist Igor Shakhman in November, the critically acclaimed Northwest New Music Ensemble under the direction of Florian Conzetti and Diane Chaplin in December; a special guest engagement by international soprano Christine Kowalsky in January; a recital by one of Northwest's newest string quartets DTQ in March and a combined performance of audience's favorite Columbia Brass Quintet and Con Grazia woodwind quintet in April.
